

RCSA LEGISLATION PROCESS

STEP 1

Legislation is one of the main ways that RCSA can express official residential opinion. Legislation can cover a variety of topic such as wellness, dining, facilities and more. **If you have a concern, research your topic and follow the steps below to draft a successful piece of legislation.**



STEP 2

Visit uwrca.org/legislation to find a downloadable template to start drafting your legislation.

STEP 3

Submit your legislation at uwrca.org/legislation. The form will ask for contact info and then offer a space to upload your file. Be sure to submit your legislation in a Word Document.

STEP 4

The RCSA General Council will review, amend and debate your legislation. You will receive a email letting you know when your legislation will be considered at General Council. You will be required to attend to present your legislation.

STEP 5

Once approved your legislation becomes the official resident opinion. RCSA board will follow up with administrators and campus partners to put your legislation in practice. If your legislation was denied we will floor up with you on ways to approve or gather addtional feedback
